



## **Analysis of Employer Feedback (AY 2019-2020)**

Employer feedback on the curriculum and the academic ambience was collected to gauge the effectiveness of the educational programs offered by the institution. A comprehensive effort was made to gather insights from employers across diverse industries to ensure a holistic understanding of the alignment between the curriculum and industry requirements. A total of 12 responses were collected, reflecting the perspectives of employers who regularly engage with graduates from the institution.

The feedback process entailed a structured questionnaire comprising 7 statements meticulously crafted to assess various aspects of the curriculum and student competence. Employers were invited to provide their evaluations using a 5-point Likert Scale, wherein they could express their level of agreement ranging from 1 (Strongly Disagree) to 5 (Strongly Agree), with a neutral option provided at 3 to capture neutral responses.




## Type of the Industry

## (1) How would you rate the adequacy of the current curriculum in addressing the specific knowledge, skills, attitude, and innovation required by the industry?




## (2) How would you rate the overall academic preparedness of graduates from our institution for the demands of the industry?



## (3) How satisfied are you with the communication skills of graduates from our institution?







## (4) How effectively do graduates apply problem-solving abilities in real-world scenarios?




## (5) How would you rate the level of professionalism and work ethics exhibited by graduates from our institution?
