



Analysis of Alumni Feedback (AY 2020-2021)

Alumni feedback on the curriculum and academic environment was collected to gather valuable information about the effectiveness of the educational programs offered by the institution. A comprehensive effort was made to reach out to alumni representing diverse cohorts and departments to ensure a holistic understanding of their perspectives and experiences.

A meticulously designed questionnaire comprising 9 statements was utilized to collect feedback from alumni, covering various aspects related to the curriculum and academic ambience. Alumni were invited to provide their evaluations using a 5-point Likert Scale, allowing them to express their level of agreement with each statement, ranging from 1 (Strongly Disagree) to 5 (Strongly Agree), with a neutral option provided at 3 for capturing neutral responses. A total of 187 alumni from various departments and graduating batches participated in this process.

The primary objective of gathering alumni feedback was to evaluate the long-term impact of the educational programs and academic experiences offered by the institution. By engaging with alumni who have moved into professional roles or continued their academic journeys, the institution sought to gain insights into the relevance of the curriculum, the quality of academic instruction, and the preparedness of graduates for their career paths.



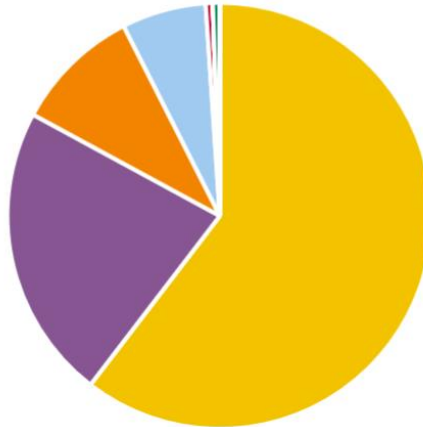

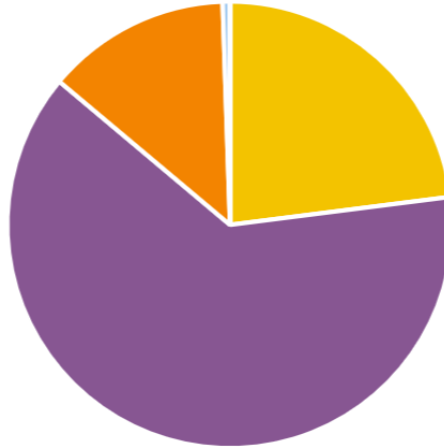
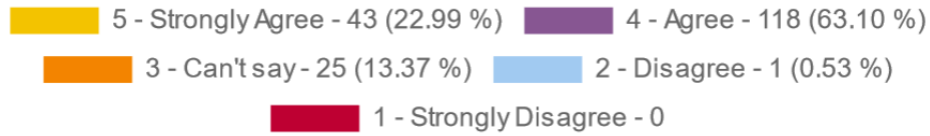
(1) How would you rate the overall atmosphere conducive to academic learning within the Institute premises?



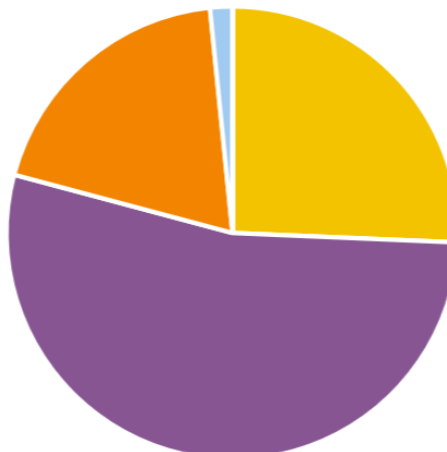
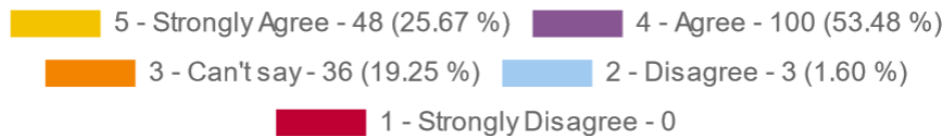
(2) How satisfied were you with the quality of education and academic programs offered during your time at the Institute?



(3) Do you believe that the curriculum effectively addresses topics that can enable better performance of students in the work environment?

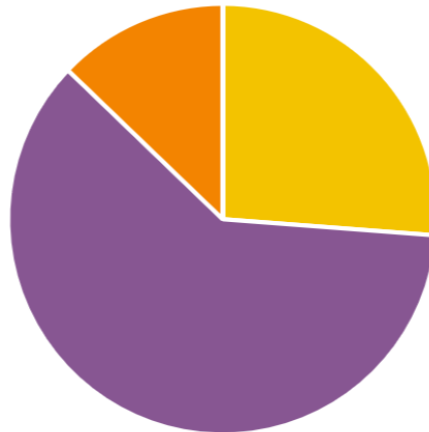
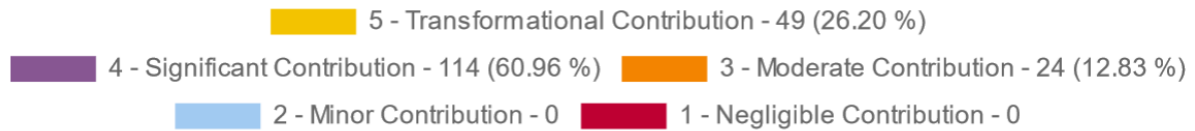


(4) Do you believe that the current syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics, global issues, and emerging global and national trends in Engineering and Technology?

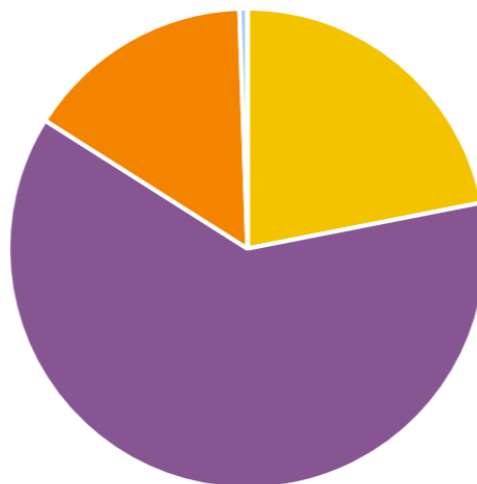
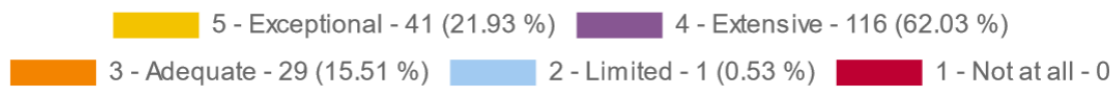




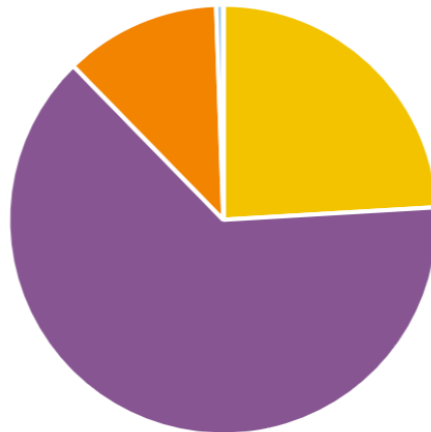
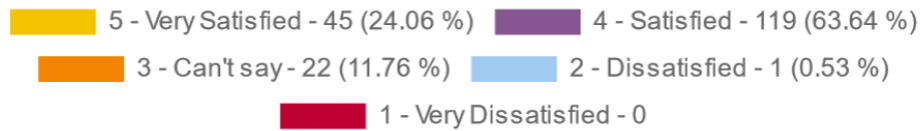
(5) To what extent did your educational experience at the institute contribute to your personal and professional growth?



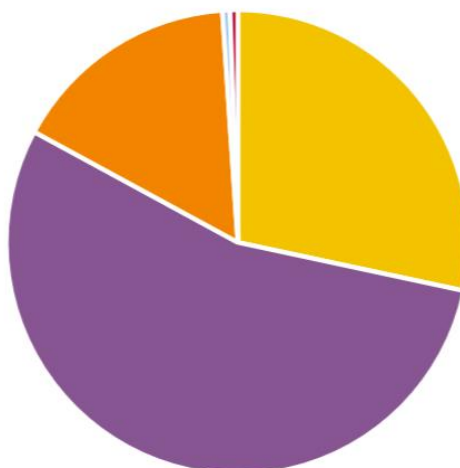
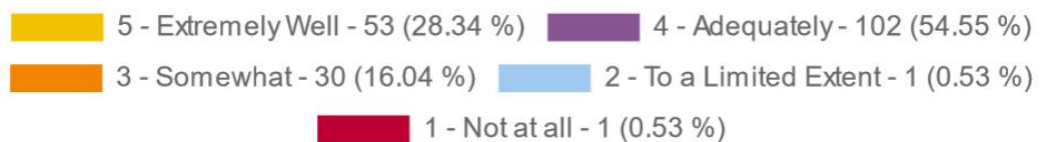
(6) To what extent did you feel that the institute offered a diverse range of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for students' holistic development during your time as a student?
