


Analysis of Student Feedback (AY 2020-2021)


Student feedback on the curriculum and academic environment was collected with a meticulous approach to assess the quality and effectiveness of the educational programs offered by the institution. A concerted effort was made to gather perceptions from graduating students across various departments, ensuring a comprehensive understanding of their experiences.

A total of 719 responses were collected, reflecting the perspectives of students who have directly engaged with the curriculum and academic environment of the institution. The feedback process involved the administration of a structured questionnaire comprising 9 statements strategically designed to evaluate different aspects of the curriculum, teaching methodologies, and overall academic ambience. Students were invited to provide their feedback using a 5-point Likert Scale, allowing them to indicate their level of agreement with each statement, ranging from 1 (Strongly Disagree) to 5 (Strongly Agree), with a neutral option provided at 3 to accommodate neutral responses.











(3) Do you believe that the current curriculum adequately covers contemporary topics, global issues, and emerging trends in Engineering and Technology?
